

# Whiskey Springs Plank Flooring



The place of Whiskey Springs came into being around the turn of the century and was among the West's early stage and freight stations. Our Whiskey Springs Plank Flooring takes time to remember the humble lives who once lived there. This random width reclaimed flooring option features the worn, natural patina of a rustic old floor. It creates a dramatic look for any home, restaurant or retail setting.

**PRODUCT COMPOSITION:** All flooring is made of solid wood reclaimed from dismantled antique buildings ranging in age from 50 –200 years old when razed. All lumber is uniformly kiln-dried to 5%-8% moisture content prior to being milled into flooring and then stored in a temperature-controlled warehouse. The flooring is machine milled, but not sanded or finished, into ¾" thick planks with an off-set "floor match" tongue and groove and end-matched in random lengths of 2'-10'. Each board is face graded and will have character markings consistent with their origins, age and grade.

**PRODUCT CHARACTERISTICS:** All flooring is considered to be original faced with the original patina. During manufacturing, the face is skip-planed but all flooring will contain more texture, or feel, than a conventionally sanded floor. Character markings consistent with nail holes, cracks, knotholes and worm tracks are very common. Color variation among natural patina is also very common.

**PRODUCT SPECIFICATIONS:** All flooring is available in either random widths 3"-6", 4"-8" or 6"-10". All flooring through 8" wide is end-matched in random lengths of 2'-10'. A 4" commercial glue-down is also available.
